

## SMALL BOWEL CAPSULE ENDOSCOPY PREPARATION

The procedure involves placing a belt with built-in electrodes around your abdomen, activating the capsule, & administering the capsule by mouth. The capsule is the size of a large vitamin. To complete the testing, you will be asked to return 8 hours after starting the procedure to have the equipment removed. A nurse will complete the test & you will not see the physician during the procedure.

\*\*If you have had any abdominal surgeries such as bowel resections, or have major scars on your abdomen, please let us know immediately. If you have a PACEMAKER or DEFIBRILLATOR, you may not be a candidate for the procedure. Your physician will advise you.\*\*

If you are taking iron supplements, please stop them 5 days prior to the test.

## The day before the procedure:

- 1. You may have a regular diet until noon. From noon until 8pm, you may only have clear liquids. Clear liquids are coffee, tea, soft drinks, Gatorade, Jell-o, popsicles or broth. DO NOT HAVE ANY MILK OR DAIRY PRODUCTS, PRODUCTS THAT CONTAIN PULP OR PIECES OF FOOD OR ANYTHING RED OR PURPLE IN COLOR.
- 2. At 7pm, please drink 1 bottle of magnesium citrate (not red). You may purchase this over-thecounter in the pharmacy. Again, you may have clear liquids until 8pm.
- 3. Please take all daily medications by 8pm the night before the procedure. If you take Carafate, do not take any for 24 hours prior to the procedure.
- 4. DO NOT HAVE ANYTHING TO EAT OR DRINK AFTER 8PM THE NIGHT BEFORE THE PROCEDURE.
- 5. Do not take any antacids the day before or the day of the procedure.

Once you arrive for the procedure the nurse will give you instructions regarding medications, food & liquids for the day.
